The Inland Valley Symphony is a well-established and accomplished community symphony based in Temecula, CA under the musical direction of Maestro Anthony Parnter. Providing cultural enrichment through orchestral performance and education the symphony fosters musical development and arts awareness for youth and its members and promotes the appreciation of music for the greater Inland Valley area. Now in its fifteenth season, the symphony has grown both in size as well as artistic achievement. The Inland Valley Symphony is a 501 (c)(3) non-profit corporation governed by a volunteer board of community leaders and orchestra members.

Mr. Parnter is in his inaugural season as Conductor and Music Director of the Inland Valley Symphony. Anthony also conducts and is the Music Director of the Orange County Symphony, and is the Founding Conductor of both the Orange County Wind Symphony and the critically-acclaimed Appalachian Brass Orchestra. He has performed with, or conducted in concert, noted soloists and has been featured as a conductor in virtually every musical medium. Mr. Parnter is an accomplished bassoonist and professional musician, composer, arranger, and music educator who is in demand nationally as a guest conductor and adjudicator.

Awards

First Place: \$300*

(includes concerto performance with the symphony on two May concerts)

Second Place: \$200

Third Place: \$100

*The winner will be invited to perform his or her concerto with the Inland Valley Symphony for the Young People's Concert on May 23 and May 27, 2010.

Other qualified applicants may also be selected to perform with the symphony on the Young People's Concert.

Contestants will be notified regarding the time and place of his or her audition at least 10 days before the competition.

Eligibility Requirements

- Auditions are open to any student through Grade 12 who will be no more than 18 years of age as of May 31, 2010.
- Applicant must reside in one of the following counties: Riverside, San Bernardino, Los Angeles, Ventura, Orange or San Diego.
- Previous first place winners are not eligible to audition on the same instrument.
- A NON-refundable entry fee of \$25.00 must accompany application form and be postmarked by Mar. 1, 2010. Please make checks payable to the Inland Valley Symphony.

Repertoire Requirements

- All instrumental contestants should prepare one movement of a concerto taken from **Standard Orchestral Repertoire**.
- Memorization is not required but is highly encouraged.
- Each contestant must provide his or her own accompanist.
- A time limit of 15 minutes will be allowed for each contestant.

Adjudication

Contestants must provide a copy of the work to be performed for the judges.

Adjudication panel will consist of professional musicians from each instrument family.

IVS members who have students competing will not be eligible to sit on the panel.
